Challenge Facility Request

Camp dining halls and kitchens at Daisy Hindman, Oakledge, Prairie Schooner and Woodland can be reserved for overnight service unit camping events. An additional fee of \$100 per day applies. (Fri. night-Sun. afternoon = 2 days)

Fees and Payment

Service Unit Camping Deposit

- A deposit of \$50 must be submitted with each troop camping reservation request. Fees are determined on a per-person, per-night basis with a minimum fee of \$50 per request. Deposit cannot be magazine credit.
- Balance due must be paid at least 4 weeks prior to reservation date.

Service Unit Camping Fees

- \$2.00 per person per night, \$1.00 per person per day use

REFUND POLICY

Camping reservation deposits are applied to the camp fee. Balance due must be paid in full 4 weeks prior to the reservation date. Failure to pay the balance due will result in cancellation of the reservation and loss of the deposit. If the service unit cancels a reservation less than four weeks out, no money will be returned to the service unit. Deposit and fees will be forfeited. In the event that the camp is closed due to severe weather, deposits and fees will be refunded.

Registrations completed less than 4 weeks prior to the reservation date must be paid in full at the time of registration.
