



2009 Resident Camp Timeline

Date	Action
Today:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Call your physician to schedule a health exam if your camper needs one. Health exam must be current within 24 months of the end of her camp session.
30 days before camp, please submit:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Final payment• Completed health form• Completed camper profile• Camper release form• Trading Post deposit
2 weeks before camp	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Start packing! It's almost time for camp.• Today is also the last date to turn in forms and payment.• Talk to your daughter about going to camp. Help her get excited and ready to be at camp.• Contact your health insurance provider. Check to make sure your daughter will be covered for medical treatment provided by out-of-camp clinics or hospitals.• Visit the pharmacy if needed. Make sure you have enough of your camper's medications to last the entire camp session. Be sure to send 2 inhalers in case one is lost or broken.
3-5 days before camp	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Send a letter to your camper! That way, she'll get some mail from home during the first mail call on the first or second day of camp.
Within 2 weeks of her return home	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complete the parent evaluation form your camper brings home from camp.• Call the Girl Scout office to ask about any items your camper lost.
