The Bronze Award of Excellence recognizes an existing Partnership where the contributions provided by the partner have gone above expectations and significantly benefited Girl Scouts of Mid-Continent Council.

The Bronze Award of Excellence is a certificate and is awarded by an individual staff member or volunteer at any time during the year.

Criteria

Candidates who meet the following criteria may be presented a Bronze Award of Excellence.

- There is a current Partnership Agreement between the partner organization and Girl Scouts of Mid-Continent Council.
- The partner has made a significant contribution to the success of Girl Scouting.

Examples of Bronze Award Recipients

- A partnership with a church to recruit mentors for girls results in twice as many volunteers due to the organization's promotion and enthusiasm.
- A skating rink that has consistently provided low cost programs to Girl Scouts hosts an all-night camp-out when weather interferes with the plans.

Procedures

1. Complete the application form found on page 2 or on the council Web site, at www.girlscoutsmcc.org, and click on *What Can I Do?/ Be A Partner*, and submit it to Field Staff.
2. Maintain a copy of this application for Service Unit records.
3. Girl Scouts of Mid-Continent Council will complete the Bronze Award Certificate as directed and send it back to the specified person. A copy of the application will be kept at the council office.
4. Arrange for an appropriate presentation of the certificate (service unit recognition event, ceremony at place of business, etc.)
