

Program Kits

Program kits are designed to enhance the Girl Scout program experience. Kits may be checked out at the council office.

Animal Tracks

Ages:

All levels of Girl Scouts

This kit is designed to teach girls about the different animal tracks they may find in Missouri and/or Kansas. Kit contains over 30 animal tracks, casting material and ideas on what to do with the materials in it. A great Day Camp resource!

Bird Observation

Ages:

7-17 year old Girl Scouts

This kit is designed to assist girls in bird watching and learning interesting trivia about birds. Kits contains 3 binoculars, easy to use bird identification guide, specific bird tracks, and a fun bingo game. This is a great resource to complement bird counts or use during a troop meeting.

Bridging The Gap (BTG)

Ages:

5-17 year old Girl Scouts

Tubs contain everything needed to bring science, engineering and math to troop meetings. Tubs are designed to earn Girl Scout recognition such as a Badge or Try-It. Tubs are checked out through the Service Unit **BTG** Coordinator

From Sidewalks to Tree tops

Age:

9-17 year old Girl Scouts

Complete with video and leader guide, this environmental program helps girls of all levels discover the wildlife and plants that live in their city through many exploratory activities.

GameFace

Ages:

10-13 year old Girl Scouts

Each kit includes sports related photo cards with discussion questions that target youth issues like body image, competition, friendship, gender roles, risk-taking and more.

A Healthier You

Ages:

8-11 year old Girl Scouts

This kit is a fun way to help girls develop a healthy lifestyle by getting enough daily activity and servings of calcium. Tubs include activities for the Junior Badges: A Healthier You,” “Fun and Fit,” and “Walking For Fitness.” The tubs are complete with Leader guide, step counters for each girl, activity and nutrition charts, and other materials needed to get girls involved in building strong bones. Plan to check the tubs for a month.

Horse Rider Preparation Kit 1

Ages:

9-11 year old Girl Scouts

This kit gets girls ready for their Level 1 Ponytail Horse Program. The kit has safety tips, examples of saddles and bridles and activity cards.

Horse Rider Preparation Kit 2

Ages:

9-11 year old Girl Scouts)

This kit gets girls ready for their Level 2 Weanling Horse Program. The kit contains information about safety, horse body parts and knots.

In the Pink

Ages:

11-17 year old Girl Scouts

“In the Pink” is an Interest Project Patch, which teaches girls about self-detection and focuses on technology, community service and career exploration related to breast health and breast cancer. The kit contains a video, program ideas, breast self-exam shower cards, cancer information/resources and breast models.

Japanese Kit

Ages:

5-17 year old Girl Scouts

Learn about what Girl Guiding is like in Japan. This kit contains sample uniforms, books and many other resources for troops to use.

Laptop Computers

Ages:

6-17 year old Girl Scouts

The leader, or adult volunteer, can bring three popular Plugged-In programs to a troop meeting via laptop computers. **Laptop training by the council is required.**

Leather Tooling Kit

Age:

9 - 17 year old Girl Scouts

Explore a new craft with this kit. It contains lots of leather punches, mallets, boards and many other resources for girls to use.

Lewis & Clark

Ages:

6-17 year old Girl Scouts

These trunks will help your troop learn more about the journey and work towards the Bicentennial Lewis and Clark Patch. (Patch requirements can be found at www.girlscoutsmcc.org.) Trunks include books, craft ideas, pictures, costumes, etc. to help your troop travel back to 1804!

Ages:

6-17 year old Girl Scouts

Ages:

5-17 year old Girl Scouts

This kit helps troops work on program goal #4—relating to others. There are two *Talking with TJ* kits, Conflict Resolution and Teamwork.
