Application

The Bronze Award of Excellence recognizes a group in the community who has partnered with Girl Scouts and whose service has significantly benefited girls.

The Bronze Award of Excellence is a certificate and is awarded by an individual staff member or volunteer.

CRITERIA:

Candidates who meet the following criteria may be presented a Bronze Award of Excellence.

- There is a current partnership agreement between the group and the Girl Scouts.
- The group has made a significant contribution to the success of Girl Scouting.

Procedures:

- Submit application form to council office to request Bronze certificate.
- Maintain record of honoree in council office.

Presentation:

- Arrange for appropriate presentation of the certificate (service unit recognition event, ceremony at place of business, program site, etc.)

WHO QUALIFIES?

Potential candidates for The Bronze Award of Excellence include:

- A partnership with a church to recruit mentors for girls results in twice as many volunteers due to the organization's promotion and enthusiasm.
- A skating rink that has consistently provided low cost programs to Girl Scouts hosts an all-night camp-out when weather interferes with the plans.
